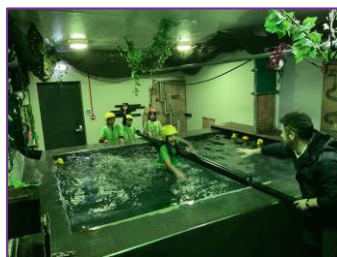
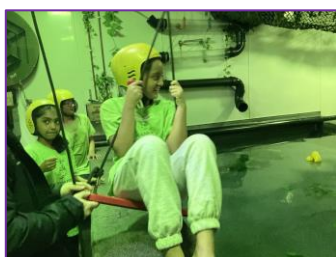
## Key Stage One
