This week we have been showing how we can be proactive by:

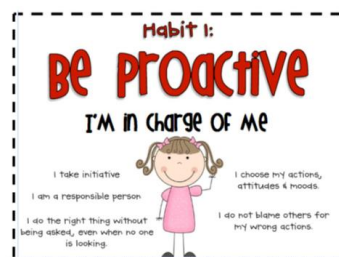
being responsible for ourselves
