**Solution** is our #wordoftheweek

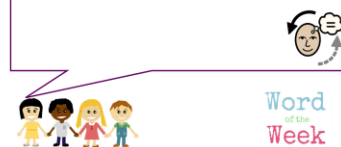
A **solution** is when you find an answer to a problem.
