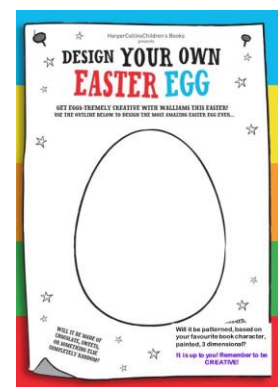
<b>Coral</b>	Ishaq for always working hard in everything he does
